Sessions: At each session the entire group gathers together in the main room to play games, to worship together, to hear testimonies and stories of God at work, and to hear preaching from God's word.

Morning Devotions + Team Time: Each morning you will gather together with your Anthem Cup Team* for a devotion provided by M28 staff. Most nights after the sermon you will gather together with your team to discuss what you have just heard from God's word.

Free Time: Each day we have free time from 1pm to 6pm. There are optional organized activities during these times for everyone to participate in, but otherwise you can use this time to hang out with friends, spend time on the beach or at the pool, take a much needed nap, etc.

Pier Park: You'll notice that on Thursday afternoon from 3:30 to 6:30 we will be going to Pier Park. This is an opportunity to spend a little time away from the retreat center. Pier Park is a board walk where you can do some shopping and exploring if you would like. While at Pier Park everyone will get dinner (This is one of the few meals that you are responsible for, it is not covered by the cost of the trip like most other meals are. The only other times that this is the case is any meals we eat on the bus ride down to Florida and the bus ride back).

* These are 8 teams each led by a pair of students, and everyone attending Anthem will be divided amongst them. Your particular cup team will be determined by the first game we play on Monday morning. Throughout the week you will compete in various games with your team to earn points in the hopes of winning the Anthem Cup. As well as participating in games with your team, you will spend time with the members of your team throughout the week discussing the morning devotions, what you are learning from God's word during the course of the week, what God is doing in your life, etc.
